Item 1: *Chairs updates*

Discussion:

- SW Artifacts inventory
 - The projects intern is compiling an inventory of the University's SW artifacts including items designed by Meem, furniture and decorative items.

 - Items will be tagged with inventory numbers
 - The inventory is planned to be linked to UNM's FAMIS special data base so items can be located easily.
